




BLEXTING FIELD SURVEY PROCESS










Completed survey results

collected in the field.










 A mobile application to understand property information in Detroit

Lets Blext!!!


- In the Explore menu, your location is represented by the star icon.
- Individual parcels are displayed on the map.
- Clicking on the magnifying glass allows you to search for an address.
- Dragging with your finger moves you around the map, return to your location by clicking on the arrow on the bottom left of the screen.





Clicking on a parcel brings up an information panel


Information related to property
