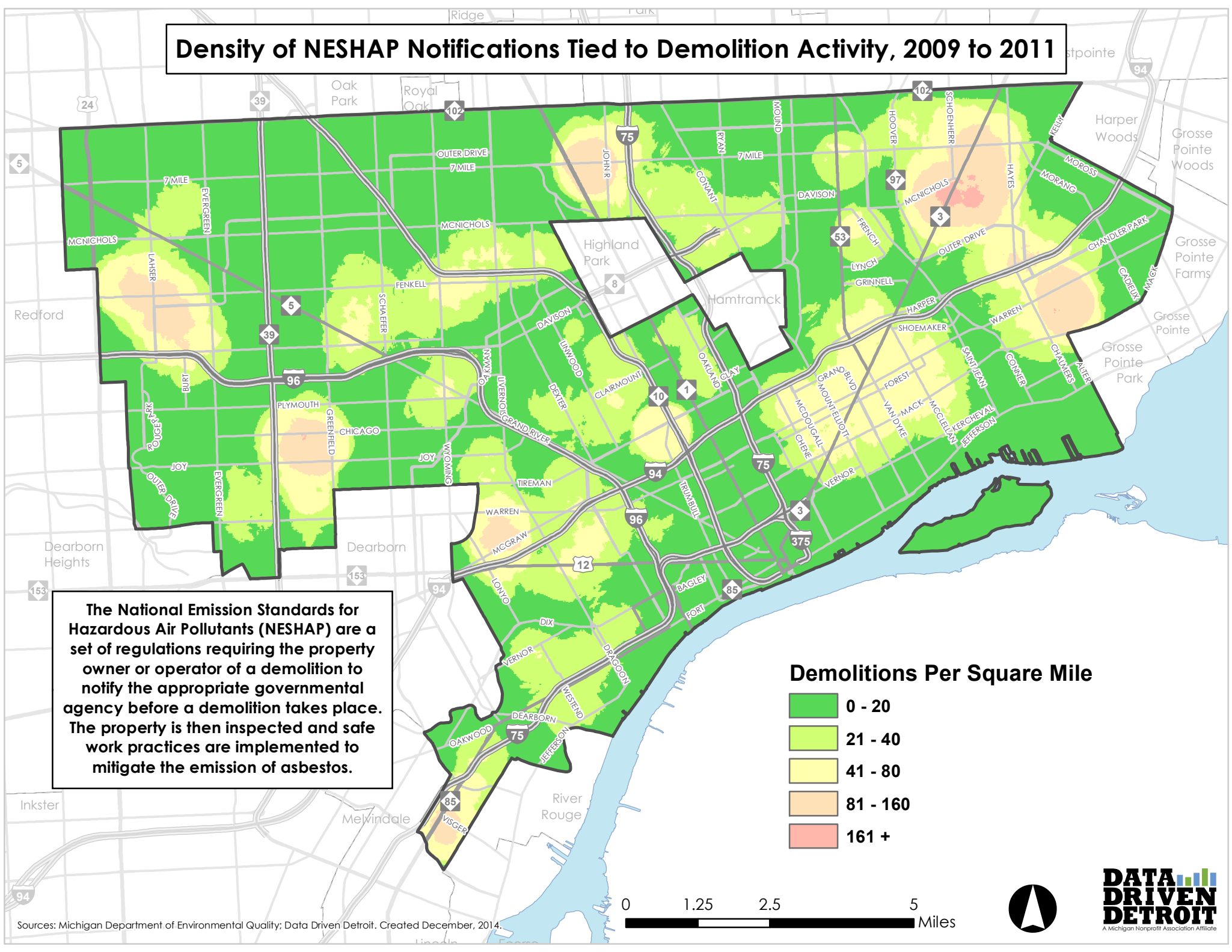


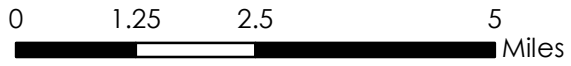
# Density of NESHAP Notifications Tied to Demolition Activity, 2009 to 2011



The National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) are a set of regulations requiring the property owner or operator of a demolition to notify the appropriate governmental agency before a demolition takes place. The property is then inspected and safe work practices are implemented to mitigate the emission of asbestos.
